Who is St. John Vianney?

St. Jean Marie Baptiste Vianney (1786—Aug. 4, 1859) was a French parish priest who became a Catholic saint and the patron saint of parish priests. He is often referred to, even in English, as the “Cure d’ Ars” (the parish priest of the village of Ars, France). He became famous internationally for his priestly and pastoral work in his parish due to the radical spiritual transformation of the community and its surroundings. Catholics attribute this to his saintly life, mortification, and persevering ministry in the sacrament of confession. Vianney had a great devotion to St. Philomena. In the year 1925 Pope Pius XI canonized him and assigned August 8 as his feast day.
